The application deadline is October 29, 2010, meaning that all applications must arrive at the KDI School by this date.

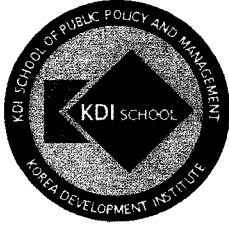
