- **Purpose:** Promote higher education opportunities in a European environment to Japanese students and universities. Create network opportunities between Japanese and European higher education institutions.
- **Participants:** Education promotion officers from European higher education institutions, European embassy higher education promotion officers based in Japan, European Union study and research programme officers. Each participant will be allocated its own space and will be given a table to place publicity brochures and a panel to display its own graphic elements.
- **Visitors:** Students (high school, undergraduate, postgraduate), general public. 1500 visitors are expected over the three day period.
- **Promotion:** Poster and flyers will be produced and distributed to all interested parties and potential visitors. A dedicated website for the fair will be created, and extensive use made of social media. A catalogue with information on all participating universities and countries will be published and distributed during the event. Press releases will be issued.
- **Presentations/Seminars:** Themed presentations and seminars will be held throughout the event.
- **Networking Reception:** A networking reception will be held for EHEF exhibitors and representatives of key Japanese higher education institutions the evening of 16 May at Meiji University.
- **Financing:** The event is to be jointly funded by the Directorate General for Education and Culture of the European Commission, and exhibitor participation fees (EUR 300 for Tokyo, EUR 500 for Tokyo and Kansai). All accommodation/travel expenses must also be borne by participating institutions.
