The official establishment of “China - Central and Eastern European Countries (CEEC) Cooperation (16+1 Cooperation)” mechanism in 2012, has created a new platform for the cooperation between China and CEEC. Over the past several years, the “16+1 Cooperation” has grown both in size and depth and has become increasingly abundant and mature.
