AMEXCID is an agency of the Mexican Ministry of Foreign Affairs, created on September 28th, 2011 with specific authority to address issues related to international development cooperation.

VISITING PROFESSORS

Program Description:

Grants for specialists, researchers and/or professors to give special lectures, courses, workshops, and/or seminars in Mexican Higher Education Institutions or Research Centres for a minimum of four hours per week.

Candidate Profile: Must come from a Higher Education Institution or Research Centre, hold a Ph.D. or have extensive experience teaching/research and be an expert in the subject of the lecture, course, workshop or seminar.

Length:

Minimum: One month Maximum Six months

Benefits:

- · Monthly stipend
- · Round-trip international transportation
- Round-trip transportation from Mexico City to the host institution
- Health insurance

HIGH - LEVEL CONFERENCES "GENARO ESTRADA" SCHOLARSHIP

Program Description:

Grants for international experts, researchers and scholars to give high-level conferences in Mexican academic, research, social and cultural institutions

Candidate Profile: Hold a Ph.D. or demonstrate extensive experience teaching/research in the field of knowledge in which will develop its academic activity in Mexico.

Length:

Minimum: One week Maximum: One month

Benefits:

- Round-trip international transportation
- Round-trip transportation from Mexico City to the host institution

FOR SPECIALISTS IN MEXICAN STUDIES

Program Description:

Research grants for Senior International Specialists in Mexican studies.

Candidate Profile: Must be an expert on a topic related to Mexico with an established academic career.

Host Institutions in Mexico: Higher education institutions, archives, libraries research centres cultural institutions, amongst others.

Length:

Minimum: One month Maximum: Twelve months

Benefits:

- Monthly stipend
- Round-trip international airfare
- Round-trip transportation from Mexico City to the host institution
- Health insurance

ARTIST RESIDENCIES

Program Description:

Grants to create a piece of art in Mexico under the guidance of an expert in the field, either national or foreign, resident of Mexico. The grant does not cover research. courses, seminars, workshops, performances or exhibitions.

Candidate Profile: The applicant must have a proven record in the type of artistic creation for which the grant is requested.

Host Institutions: Academic studios, cultural and artistic institutions and workshops, as well as individual artists committed as advisors providing guidance and space needed to carry out the artistic project.

Length:

Minimum: One month Maximum Six months

Benefits:

- Monthly stipend
- Round-trip international airfare
- Round-trip transportation from Mexico City to the host institution
- Health insurance

MEDIA RESIDENCIES

Program Description:

This program is offered to international media professionals who are interested in writing articles and reports and conducting interviews in Mexico.

Candidate Profile: Media professionals who are currently working in their field.

Length:

Minimum: One week Maximum: One month

Benefits:

- Monthly stipend
- · Round-trip international airfare
- Round-trip transportation from Mexico City to the host institution
- Health insurance

IMPROVING THE QUALITY OF MEXICAN HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTIONS

Program Description:

Grants for education specialists and international education administrators to deliver conferences. courses and workshops and to exchange experiences and best practices with Mexican educational administrators, seeking to impact the quality, internationalization and administration of Mexican public higher education institutions.

Candidate Profile: Must be an expert in the topic of the conference. course, workshop or exchange of experiences and best practices.

Mexican Host Institutions: Public Higher Education Institutions.

Length:

Minimum: One week Maximum: One month

Benefits:

- One-time stipend
- Round-trip international airfare
- Round-trip transportation from Mexico City to the host institution




Furthermore, Mexico offers a magnificent and vast cultural, historical, tourist and gastronomic richness that makes it a unique destination.
